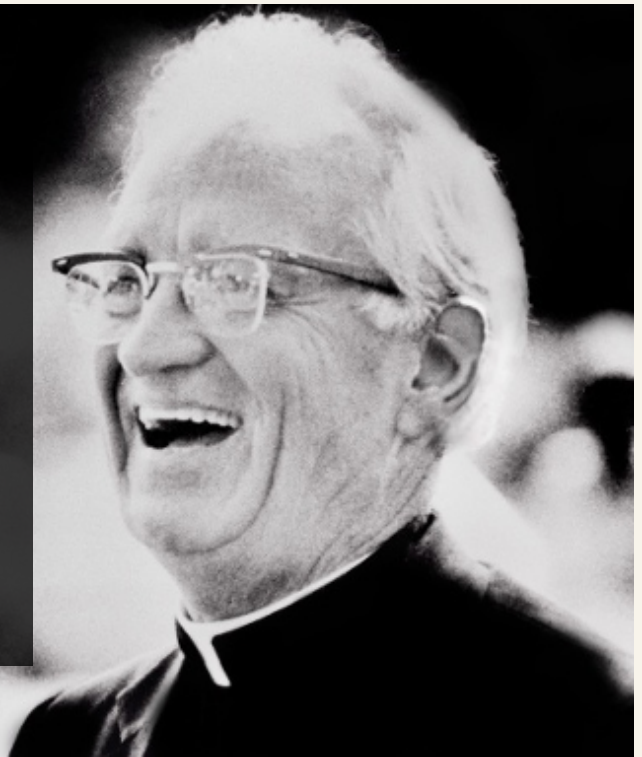

Sr. Elaine Hagedorn

Hearing a faith call to peace-making Sr. Elaine volunteered with numerous peace organizations and has served since 2001 on the Catholic Peace Ministry board. Sister Elaine has been a consistent presence whenever there was a call for peace or an opportunity to stand with the immigrant or the oppressed or the marginalized.

While still a teenager Jeanie joined the Congregation of the Humility of Mary Sisters and has spent the rest of her life answering her call to serve God in teaching, serving the poor, and working toward a world of peace and justice. In addition to her local work, Jeanie also served on the leadership team of the Congregation of Humility of Mary and was for many years the Peace & Justice coordinator.
